WSM – Saturday, Mar. 11th, 2023 - Session Summary (*The Art of Listening*, *Public Speaking*, *Debate*...)

When: Saturdays - 10:00 a.m. until 12:15 p.m.

Where: Naperville North High School or Alive, Naperville Teen Center

The Art of Listening, Public Speaking & Debate - March 11th (Facilitator: Mr. Albert Demming)

Saturday's session facilitated by Mr. Demming, focused on "<u>Debate Preparation...</u>". Highlighted were the importance of Effective Active Listening, Public Speaking, and Debate Preparation Practices.

- Effective Active Listening: Defined as a communication technique used in a variety of ways, including Daily Life, suggesting listeners repeat what they've received from the speaker, either by restating or paraphrasing what was heard in their own words. The definition was followed by examples and methods on how to demonstrate the practice.
- Effective Public Speaking: Highlighted five (5) Secrets to Speaking with Confidence: One's Stance; Sound; Smile; use of Silence/Pause/Timing; and Eye Contact. Also shared were ten (10) steps to reduce presentation anxiety. However, Mr. Demming emphasized recording & playing back your presentation, and critiquing yourself; presenting in front of a mirror, as well as family and friends who will offer constructive feedback. Preparation + Practice are Keys to a Experiencing Successful Presentation Outcomes.
- <u>Debate Preparation</u>: Mr. Demming shared the difference between a <u>Debate</u> and an <u>Argument</u>; the <u>five (5) Key Steps in a Debate</u>; the use of <u>Connecting Words</u>; <u>as well as ten (10) practices one</u> should remember in preparation for a <u>Debate competition</u>.
