Saturday, April 30, 2022, Session Summary - “Team Building Activity...”

“Team Building...”

The objective of Saturday’s interactive session, led by Mr. Demming, was to have students learn a little more about one another. The meeting opened with a Discovery Bingo Team Building activity. Each attendee was given a form similar to a Bingo Card. The Card listed information which prompted students to find out which other student(s) shared similar truths. The activity helped students discover the many things they have in common with their fellow Mentees.

Discovery Bingo was followed by each student given one (1) minute to market themselves via an oral presentation. At the conclusion of each presentation, students were provided with positive feedback on their level of enthusiasm, mannerisms, and delivery style.

Mr. Demming then led a presentation which reminded students of their Greatness, focusing on the following key take away points:

- **Greatness:** The Attribute, Quality, Trait, or Characteristic possessed by someone who is considered to be Superior, Outstanding, Awesome, and/or Exceptional.
- **You** are the master of your destiny; only **you** can make your life as extraordinary as **You** desire
- **Believe in yourself:** You can achieve anything you desire; however, **You** must put in the work!
- You are the Intellectual Equal to anyone!
- **You** are Beautiful and Intelligent, and built to be Innovators and Leaders!
- **Surround** yourself with people who Encourage, Inspire, Stimulate, and Lift You up!

In summation, Mr. Demming emphasized to students “It’s all about and up to You...!”
