<u> Saturday, Apr. 20, 2024, Session Summary - "The Power of Tea - Money Mgt."</u>

When: Saturdays – 10:00 a.m. until 12:15 p.m.

Calming & Medicinal Power of Tea - Money Mgt. Overview (Facilitators: Cooper, Davis, Demming

During Saturday's Mentoring Session, students in attendance were educated on the relaxing, calming and medicinal benefits of various Teas (E.g., <u>Chamomile</u>, relieves anxiety and helps one sleep; <u>Green Tea</u>, improves mood, energy and memory; <u>Lavender Tea</u>, soothes and calms nerves). Miss Cooper opened the segment by providing a brief history of The Power of Tea, students were then allowed to select a mug, design it to reflect their personality, then report on their creation with the group. Students were then granted the option of sampling a selection of Teas, based on their calming and/or medicinal purpose.

Mr. Demming and Mr. Davis closed out the session by delivering an overview on Money Management which focused on: <u>Disposable & Discretionary Income</u>; <u>Smart Spending</u>; <u>Needs vs Wants</u>; <u>Budgeting</u>; and <u>Using Credit Wisely</u>. Students were then separated into teams and given a group exercise which required them to agree on how to manage their respective <u>Discretionary Income</u> after monthly expenses had been paid. Each student was given pamphlets on <u>Money Management</u> and <u>Investing</u>.
